UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS BIRMINGHAM NHS FOUNDATION TRUST

The Trust runs Good Hope, Heartlands, Solihull, and Queen Elizabeth hospitals in Birmingham and the West Midlands.

- In 2011 PCMG worked with Queen Elizabeth Hospital and Heart of England NHS Foundation Trust.
- PCMG recovered £314,652 while working with Queen Elizabeth Hospital.
- PCMG recovered £838,801 for Heart of England NHS Foundation Trust.
- In 2017 Heart of England NHS Foundation Trust and University Hospitals Birmingham NHS Foundation Trust merged.
- The now merged University Hospitals Birmingham NHS Foundation Trust signed up to PCMG's auditing services in January 2020, via the CCS Framework.
- PCMG carried out extensive analysis work, in order to uncover any overcharges and possible savings on behalf of the trust.
- To date, refunds totaling £245,100 have been recovered, with an annual saving of £229,530 secured going forward.
